We the people comprising the true landowners in custom from the many clans in Turubu Census Division and Sausso Census Division affected by the <u>direct grant of our customary lands</u> under SABL (Special Agricultural Business Lease) referenced Portion 144c have during the two (2) days meeting conducted at Tangugo Pastoral Centre have deliberated on many issues relating to customary land grants under SABL and have recommended the following to be our <u>Petition</u> to those concern in both the East Sepik Provincial Government and the National Government -

- Revoke the lease title granted under Portion 144c Milinch Tring Fourmil Wewak, Milinch Wombun, Fourmill Ambunti, East Sepik Province SABL reproduced in National Government Gazettes No.G154 and No. 145.
- All customary land under the said Portion 144c SABL in East Sepik Province be returned to its customary land owners.
- Terminate all Asians Logging Permits that have been granted in the East Sepik Province.
- All forest clearance authority in East Sepik Province must be revoked.
- No more issuance of customary land title under said Portion 144c SABL in East Sepik Province.
- 6. A thorough investigation to be carried out on all activities of public servants in various relevant government officer in East Sepik Provincial Government and if found to be in involved in breach of any laws relating to grant of such customary land, shall be prosecuted under relevant criminal provisions under the Criminal Code Act and or Public Service (Management) Act.
- 7. East Sepik Provincial Government to assist all customary landowners in their claim for damages against the Asian loggers and those officers and agents associated with them that may and does lead to fraud of customary owner's rightful entitlements for their logs and so forth.
- Certain individuals claiming to be customary landowners under their respective Census Division found to have been agents of direct grant of customary land title must be prosecuted under the Criminal Code Act.
- 9. All funds pertaining to any payments of royalties, levies, agricultural levies, provincial tax, premiums, anchorage fees, storage fees and rental fees (camp site) be frozen until such time as a court of competent jurisdiction directs.

We the people comprising the true landowners in custom from the many clans in Wosera Census Division also affected by the <u>direct grant of our customary lands</u> under SABL (Special Agricultural Business Lease) referenced Portion 55c have during the two (2) days meeting conducted at Tangugo Pastoral Centre have deliberated on many issues relating to customary land grants under SABL and have recommended the following to be our Petition to those concern in both the East Sepik Provincial Government and the National Government -

- 1. We endorse the 9 points raised as recommendations by the customary landowners in Turubu/Sausso Division which now is the basis of our Petition.
- 2. Any future projects in the Nungwaia/Sengo/Bongos area of Wosera Census Division and Kawanga/Drekikier Census Division must be dealt with by customary landowners alone and politicians must not be involved in it apart from the fact of them identifying foreign developers to bring in the investor.
- 3. Any future negotiation for projects and on matters relating to finance of any project in the said Nungwaia area must only be dealt with by true customary landowners and not agents who "fly by night" claiming to be true customary landowners. Where there are difficulties in identifying true customary landowners, a proper constituted land mediation must sit to identify true customary landowners and where there is dispute as to boundaries of customary land, the same mediation body under the relevant legislation will sit to decide on the dispute.
