**Subject: Complaint of Ambush, Assault and Threat of Life.**

I have the honour to report to your office that I was ambushed, assaulted and received threats of life when I was traveling to Meangwe II village on the 29<sup>th</sup> of September 2012, by the following persons;

- 1) Njume Leslie (worker Herakles Farms)
- 2) Scott Otu (driver Herakles Farms)
- 3) Mbange Lovette (worker Herakles Farms)
- 4) Otu Reymond (Lipenja I village) and others.

The incident occurred on the Mundemba Toko road when I was traveling to Meangwe II village for a routine environmental information and educational meeting on board a hired motor bike, accompanied by two Journalists of France 24 TV and Motopoh Esinoh (SEFE staff) , Fon Christopher Atchobang (CED), and Patrick Obase (motor bike rider). I was traveling on a motor bike which is my usual means of conveyance to the area while the others were in a pickup.

As soon as we left Mundemba, more precisely between the Korup office and Ekondo kondo resettlement village we saw a white pickup marked Mitsubishi belonging to Herakles Farms behind us. We then noticed that they vehicle was trailing us and gave way for pickup to pass. As they passed we realized that each time we stopped they too stopped. When we move they too moved.

Not sure on their plans and to be on the safe side we decided to snap them each time they stopped. In between Fabe and the Herakles signpost on along that road, I saw the pick-up and as we came near they blocked the bike from passing and brutally pull me off the moving bike assaulted me and threatening and shouting that they will kill me if I continue to opposed Herakles Farms the company which has offer them employment.

It should be noted that our organization Struggle to Economize Future Environment (SEFE) took Herakles Farms to court following Herakles Farms gross destruction of the environment and violation of Cameroon's law and non respect for the free, prior and informed consent of the local people. I think that this act is not unconnected with the incident that happened on that day. I attached herewith a medical certificate. I attached herewith a copy of my medico-legal certificate.

Sir, I urge you to use your <sup>file</sup> good of to hunt down these criminals and let justice takes it course.
