**RE: WITHDRAWAL FROM NRT CONSERVANCY MEMBERSHIP**

Further to Attached Joint Board Minutes/Resolutions made on March 8<sup>th</sup> 2022, we the undersigned Chairpersons on behalf of Ngilai West, Sarara and Sapashe Communities jointly incorporating Nalowon and Ngilai West sub-units of Namunyak Conservancy do hereby express our wish to withdraw from NRT Conservancies' Membership, effective immediately and owing to the following reasons just to mention a few;

**Mistrust and lack of transparency on financial matters - Carbon Credits share, Donor fundings, CLF and other benefits of membership**

**Continuous manipulations to sabotage operations, growth & development - Interference with community matters, creation of divisions among the community to influence decisions, insubordination of community leadership, micromanagement projects, delayed and inadequate funding to operations, abandoned responsibilities (case of RES funding despite pre-existing agreement as granters), Continuous use/hire of bloggers to maliciously paint bad pictures of Namunyak and its other potential partners to maintain status quo of underdevelopment and dependence**

**Abandoned quest for sustainability - Lack of support for community developments, capacity buildings, unjustified threats, supremacy battles and restricted interactions with other partners capable of creating synergies towards sustainability**

In view of the above, we request you terminate your funding support towards our operations as we explore other partnership options towards the same and as we, separately or jointly work with you seeking suitable engagement modalities on a few other crosscutting obligations including the new Carbon Credits Project among others.

We appreciate your cooperation and support during the course of our membership and hope that our withdrawal does not in any way cause inconvenience and would like to apologize in advance if that is the case.
